

#### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

The French Immersion (FI) program supports students to refine and develop French communication skills through studying various subjects.

#### What Happens in High School

- 10 courses in French
- Graduate with a Certificate of French Immersion Studies
- Interested Gr 12 students can challenge the Diplôme Études Langue Française (DELF)

#### The successful student:

By grade 12, French Immersion students should be striving for the B2 (independent level) within the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) and should be able to:

- express themselves with fluidity, clarity and spontaneity
- understand a wide range of long and complex texts, including subtext and nuance
- use the language effectively in social, professional or academic settings
- be themselves in French!

## THE CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

To receive a certificate of completion for the French Immersion program, students must complete 10 credits, including 4 French Language Arts courses and a minimum of 6 other courses where the language of instruction is French. This allows French Immersion students to complete the requirements for a Certificate of French Immersion Studies.

#### CHALLENGE THE DELF

The Diplôme d'Etudes en Langue Française (DELF) is a diploma issued by the French Ministry for National Education that certifies a learner's proficiency in French as an additional language. DELF diplomas are recognized around the world.

- DELF measures and certifies your level of language proficiency using an established and internationally recognized tool.
- DELF has global currency. It's calibrated to international language standards and is recognized around the world.
- Proficiency in an additional language is an asset and certified proficiency enhances the value of this asset. A DELF certificate can qualify you for study, work or other opportunities.

- DELF B2 meets the language requirement for admission to universities in France and increasingly to French-speaking universities in Canada.

Students will spend 25% of their timetable in French language instruction. Students are <u>supported in their efforts</u> to use <u>only French in class at all times</u>. Supplementary reading, book reports, journals and oral presentations form integral parts of the course.

All activities either in the classroom or out of the classroom are planned to enable the student to improve his/her communication skills.

Teaching strategies will be very similar to those used where the same subject is taught in English.

All courses follow the curriculum guidelines of the Ministry of Education, the same as those used in the regular English program.

#### **FRENCH IMMERSION TRANSPORTATION**
