## The High School Program

To graduate high school and earn an OSSD (Ontario Secondary School Diploma) students must complete:
> 30 credits: (new for 2024 entrants)

- 19 compulsory credits
- 11 elective credits
- 40 hours of community service
- Literacy requirement (test/course)
- 2 online learning (eLearning courses) *opt out available


## The Credit System

- Students earn 1 credit for every course they successfully complete ( $50 \%$ or higher)
- Students are promoted by individual courses to the next grade


## The Semester System

- Since a subject lasts only half a year, rather than the whole year, a class at high school moves twice as fast as a class at elementary school so...

Attendance is a key factor for success!
